The minutes of the November 19, 2024 regular meeting of the Mendon Township Board were submitted for consideration. A motion was made by Griffith, supported by Mathews to approve the minutes. Motion carried.

Floor Business:

- a. Dale Hutson: The rate of inflation has been terrible for the last couple of years and taxes went up 5% each of those years. Finally, inflation has come down a bit so next year, taxable is going to go up 3.1%. Land divisions – there are two new ones. We had other ones that didn't make sense so we did some adjusting for that.
- b. Supervisor Kline reported he attended the annual Road Commission meeting. The road commission is proposing to redo Simpson Rd. from Nottawa to M66. The cost of this project is \$122,000.00. The Township's 50% share will be \$61,000.00. Treasurer Griffith: We are getting ready to work on the budget so we can discuss this.

Old Business:

- a. Supervisor Kline-there will be a public hearing on December 18th, with the Planning Commission, regarding the biofuel digester, special use permit.
- b. County Wide Master Plan – Doug Kuhlman is absent to report on this. I (Supervisor Kline) have no idea where this is at.

New Business:

- a. None
