Chief: According to Tel-Rad, the new latest and greatest radios that everyone is moving to is the Apex N70. They are \$5867.00 each. Kline: How many of these do we need? Chief: I would like to purchase two or three at a time for now. Kline: Well, how many do you need total?? Chief: I'll count tomorrow and let you know. Griffith: The timing is not the worst because I was going to be getting with you and Casey regarding the new budget. That may mean other things will have to be put on hold.
