Floor Business:

- a. Chief Avery reported that the mirror has been replaced.
- b. The radios we received from Leonidas have turned into a goat rodeo. For the state to clone those over to Mendon frequencies we have to get some kind of form filled out from Leonidas and then that has to be filled out and submitted to the state. Then the State takes four (4) months to get it back. And there are costs involved. I'm suggesting to not move forward with this. We need at least three (3) more radios right now. We just put three (3) new firemen on. Nate Eberstein is on, but he doesn't have a radio.
- c. The written SOG's (Standard Operating Guidelines) - Casey sent them and I am working on getting those printed off.
- d. The grant from the DNR in the amount of \$4999.00 and the money we received from the dinner - \$6500.01. So, we need \$4520.00 out of the budget for the R&R quote for turnout gear, helmets, etc. A copy of the quote is incorporated with these minutes.

Old Business:

- a. Supervisor Kline: I have been in touch with Lee Belding this week from Congressman Wahlberg's office. He said Congressman Wahlberg asked him to contact us and that our application will be on the top of the list. I wanted to pass that along. He will be getting me the paperwork needed. I want to do some adjustments to the previous application we submitted. It's due in March.
