The primary item to be considered at the public hearing/meeting is the proposed St. Joseph County Joint Master Land Use Plan. The proposed joint plan includes a replacement master plan for Mendon Township with detailed demographic and existing conditions data included in the county-wide section.

Written comments may further be submitted to the Planning Commission at the public hearing/meeting.

The Planning Commission will also consider such other and further matters as shall lawfully come before it at the meeting. All interested persons are invited and requested to attend the meeting and public hearing.

Mendon Township will provide necessary, reasonable auxiliary aids and other services and accommodations at the hearing/meeting to individuals with disabilities, upon five (5) days' notice to Donna Cupp of the need for the same.
