Old Business:

- a. Township hall – there was discussion regarding hiring a cleaning service for the Township Hall. Kim Foghino, librarian was asked if she could have her cleaning lady Fanny Wickey contact the Township to discuss hiring her for the Township. Kim will get back to us.

New Business:

- a. Treasurer Griffith communicated that we will have a public hearing at our March 3, 2026 meeting for the following purposes;
 - Budget Amendment for the 2025/26 Fiscal year regarding the General Fund
 - Budget Amendment for the 2025/26 Fiscal year regarding the Library Fund
 - Present the Budget for the Fiscal year 2026/27 for approval which includes a 3.5% increase for elected officials' salaries (effective on checks dated April 1, 2026)

The January bills were submitted for consideration and approval of payment. A motion was made by Hart supported by Mathews to approve the bills. Motion carried.
